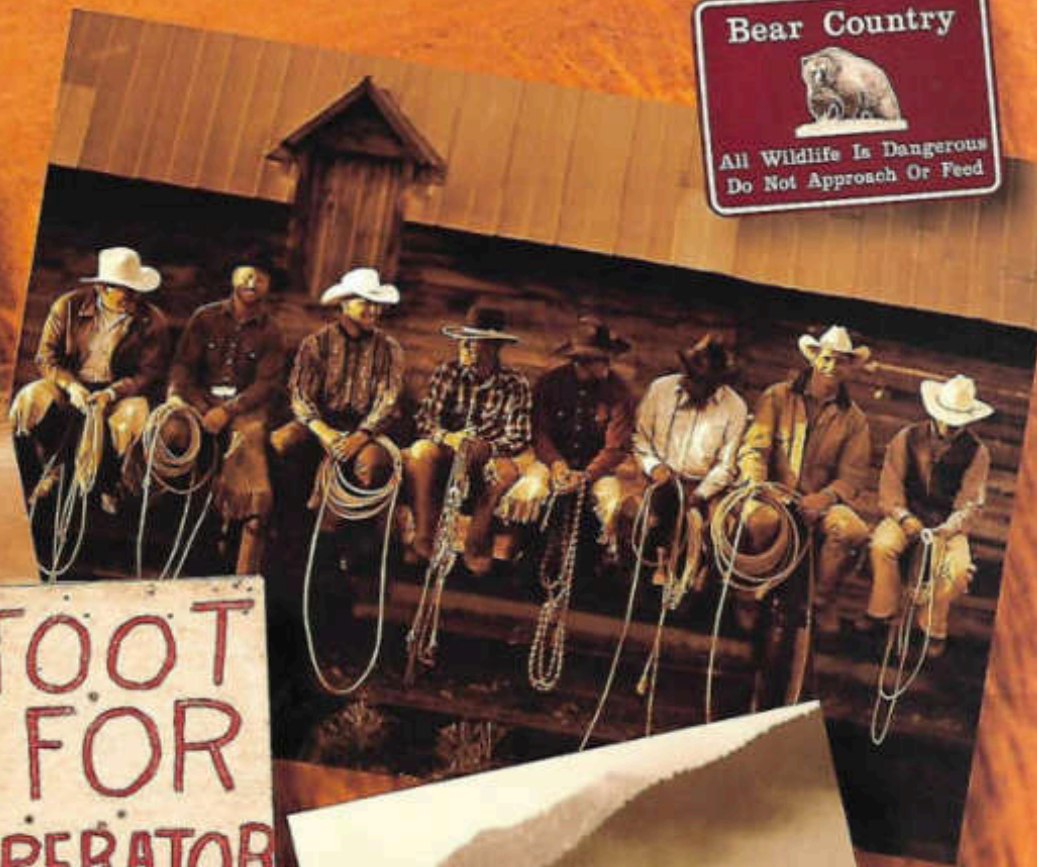

The way a horse runs reveals something about its soul. Same for a minivan. With 180 standard horsepower (among the top in the class), Montana runs with the most spirited. But this is no "one trick" pony. Beyond power, this 1998 Pontiac really handles. It should. It shares its front suspension design with the WideTrack Grand Prix. Specific to Montana are special shock absorbers that sharpen handling even





beyond that found on standard Trans Sports. Standard all-weather traction control and four-wheel anti-lock brakes further prove the point that Montana is a new breed of minivan. These dynamic features

help drivers maintain control by reducing wheel spin on most slippery surfaces and maintaining steering control during hard braking.

Eight-Passenger Seating

With second-row modular bucket seats and a three-passenger split-folding rear bench, this configuration provides comfortable seating for eight—a capability you won't find in any other front-wheel-drive minivan.

Seats are trimmed in rich Multra/Diva cloth. Available on Montana and Trans Sport.



Seven-Passenger Full Bench

Trimmed in Doral cloth, both full bench seats feature folding seatbacks and the "space on demand" convenience of fold-and-stow operation. The third-row bench also adjusts fore/aft. Maximum seating is seven. Standard on Trans Sport Regular-Length.



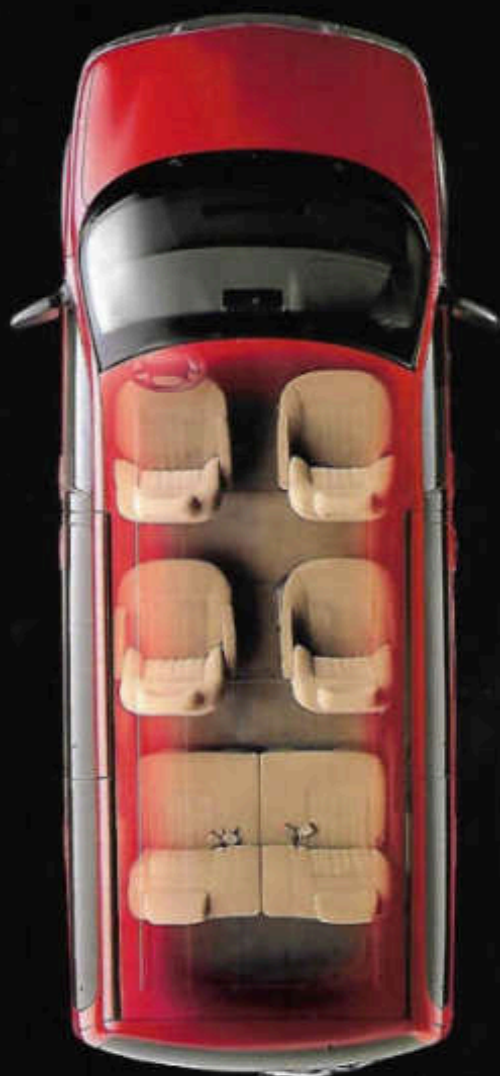
Seven-Passenger Split Bench

This choice includes Doral cloth-covered modular split-bench seats with split-folding rear seats to carry long cargo along with passengers in the rear seating area. Maximum seating is seven. Standard on Montana and Sport Extended-Length, available on Trans Sport Regular-Length.



Seven-Passenger Modular Buckets

Totally modular seating provides the most flexibility. The lightweight seats (under 40 lbs.) are covered in Multra/Diva cloth. Each rear seat may be individually folded, stowed (in the van) or totally removed. Potential cargo-seating options number in the hundreds. Maximum seating is seven. Available on Montana and Trans Sport.



Seven-Passenger Captain's Chairs

With second-row captain's chairs that are as substantial as the front seats, comfort is the attraction of the Quad Command interior. The rear bench is a split-fold design. Available in either Multra/Diva cloth or rich Prado leather seating surfaces. Maximum seating is seven. Available on Montana and Trans Sport.



Using lightweight materials such as magnesium, these easy-to-remove modular bucket seats weigh less than 40 lbs.



"Space on demand" is standard with all seating configurations thanks to seats that combine folding seatbacks with the ability to fold forward and stow into a compact area. The stowed seat opens up flat floor space for big loads, and recessed seat tracks won't damage your cargo.

Fold and stow one or the halves of the available rear bench for just the amount of space you need. The lightweight sections are easily removable.

Map pockets in the second-row doors and in the front seatbacks, plus under-the-front-passenger-seat drawer and available rear cargo nets mean there is also room for extra "stuff," from cameras to diapers or even maps.

A place for everything and everything in its place: This axiom precisely defines the interior of Montana and Trans Sport, regardless of what people decide to haul, move and shuttle. What makes these new Pontiacs so fantastically accommodating is flexibility. Fold-and-stow seating provides "space on demand" for cargo from mountain bikes to the contents of a dorm room to eight cowboys.



Providing more versatility than full bench seats found in competitive minivans, Montana is equipped with modular, split-folding bench seats that enable drivers to carry both long cargo and passengers in the rear seating area.

Western hospitality always manages to find space for a friend. And so does Montana, where there is room to spare and seats aplenty. In this Pontiac, ergonomic emphasis was not only focused on the driver's personal environment (all controls are at your fingertips), but where passengers sit as well. The open seating arrangements afford easy walk-through access to the second and third rows from the front, important for those traveling with youngsters. Young or old, those in the rear will appreciate the

heater seating: The second-row seats are higher than the front seats, and the third-row seats are higher than the second. Experts attest that this arrangement helps reduce motion sickness because of the improved outward visibility. With the exception of the standard seating on regular-length Trans Sports, all rear seats also recline, have fore/aft adjustability and are easily removable by one person. Regardless of which interior you select, their flexibility will work to meet your changing day-to-day needs.

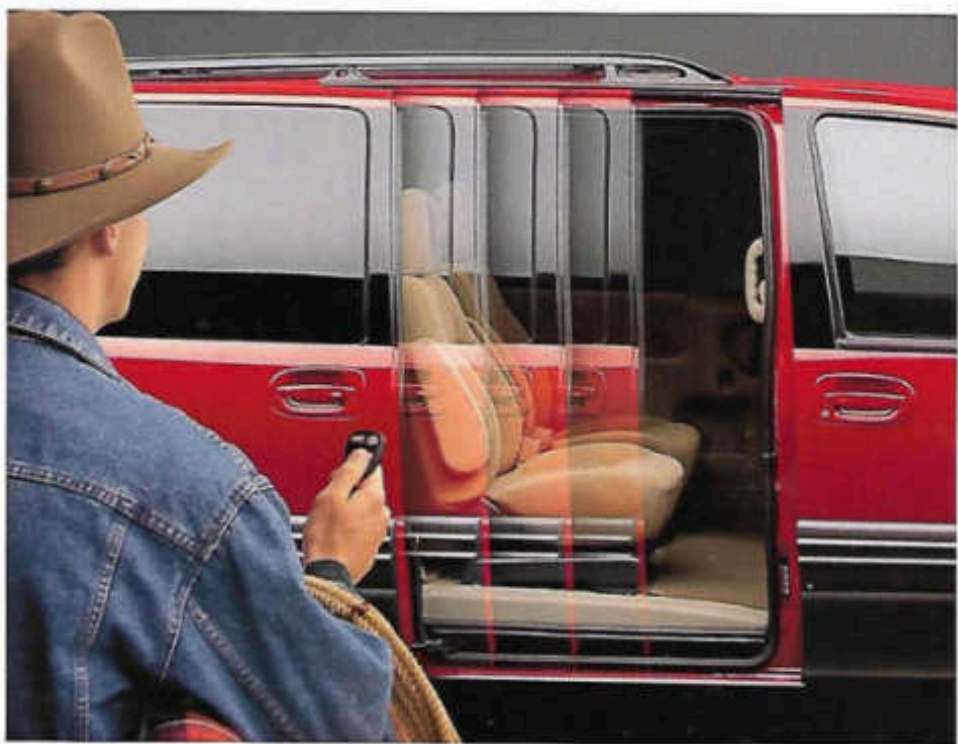

Need a hand with the door? An industry-first* power sliding door (passenger side) is available on Montana and Trans Sport in both regular and extended-length models.**

Montana is known for its wide-open spaces. The state is too. But unlike the remote sections of Big Sky country, all of Pontiac's Montana is easy to access. Aside from having a generously sized sliding door on the passenger side of the vehicle



(Montana's opens wider than those offered on Chrysler minivans), Montana provides a driver side

sliding door on all models and in both wheelbase lengths. Montana's large rear hatch also opens tall to give those loading plenty of head room. The ability of Montana's seats to flip forward makes simple child's play of third-row entry and exit—even from the driver's side.



Montana's standard rear and side cargo nets help keep smaller items in place.




With plenty of head room (compared to loading competitors), Montana's hatch struts (right) are positioned out of the way to further ease loading.

Montana's functional roof rack provides additional cargo-hauling options.

saddle or driver's seat, when you're there, you need to be comfortable, in control and have everything you need close at hand. Montana and Trans Sport have interiors built around this principle. Starting with the driver's seat (shown at left), this is one saddle that won't need to be broken in to be comfortable.



The accessory net between the front seats helps keep the things you need close at hand (day planner, cell phone, purse, etc.).

Perhaps cowboys would be even quicker to get back in the saddle again if it came with adjustable lumbar support. Beyond delivering an excellent over-the-road view, comfort and support, its design incorporates a fold-forward seatback that gives you clear access to the second row for storing things like picnic baskets or briefcases.



Available steering wheel radio controls enable drivers to keep their hands on the wheel while controlling the sound system.

With a forward-folding driver's seatback, access to the second row is an easy proposition.



Like saddle bags, all Trans Sports give their drivers dozens of storage options for keeping track of small carry-along items you don't want loose on the floor.

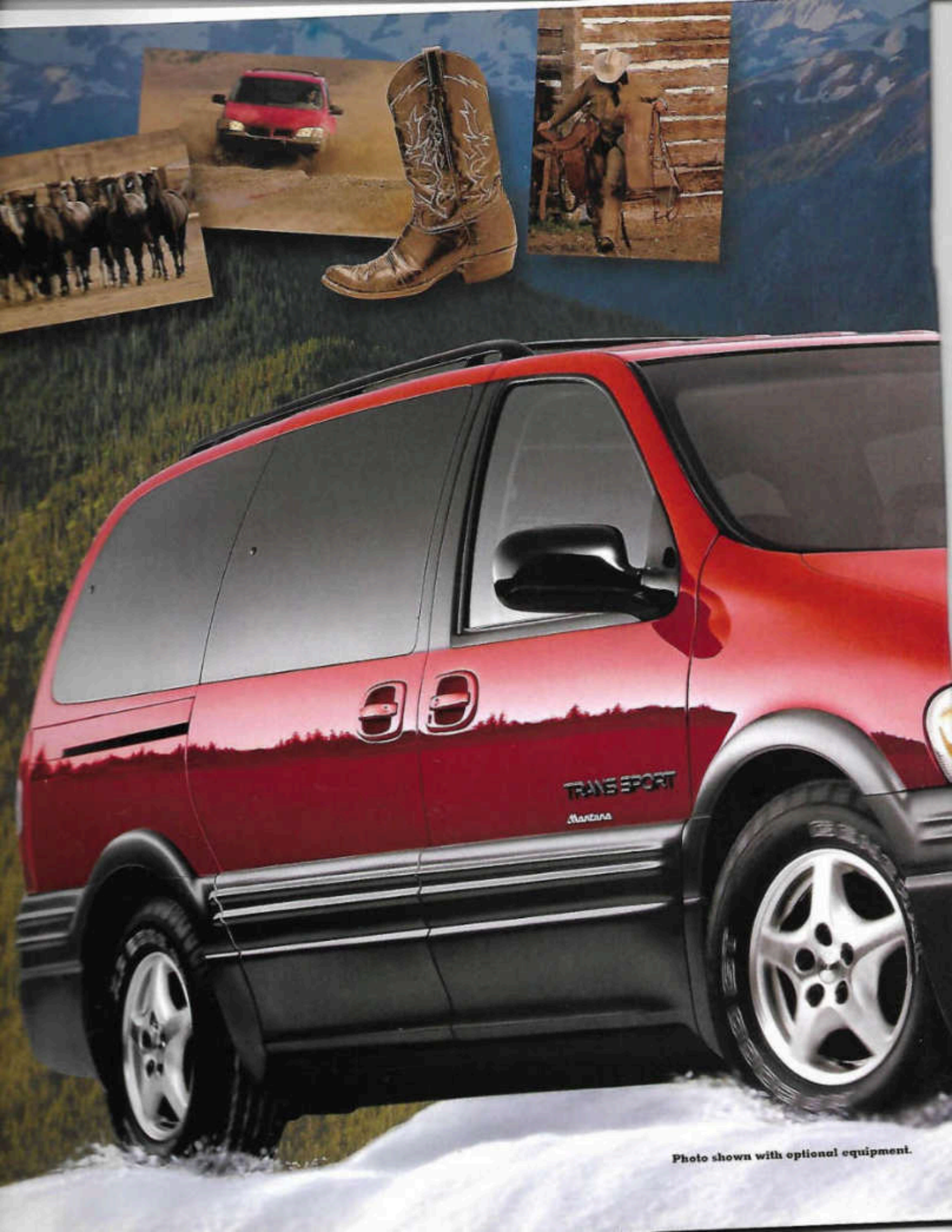

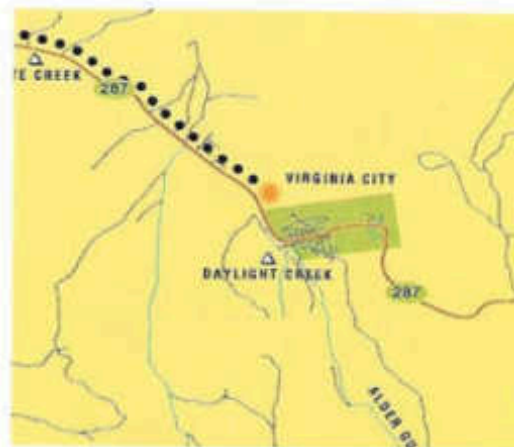

Like Montana, Trans Sport's trendsetting appearance presents a rugged, dramatic entry into the otherwise conservative (or could we say "boring") minivan market. Beyond its aerodynamically efficient flush glass, hidden windshield wipers and windshield-encased antenna, Trans Sport faces the road with Pontiac's signature split grille and fog lamps: indicators of this van's excellent road manners. Available in two wheelbase lengths, Trans Sport may also be ordered in a contemporary monotone paint scheme.

The way people use minivans makes this breed of vehicle nothing less than a mobile "home on the range." Pontiac understands that flexibility yields versatility, and that's why each of the features pictured on these pages is either standard or available on Montana and Trans Sport. Beyond all the items shown, all Trans Sports also provide a wide array of standard features that make living out on the range comfortable, fun and secure, including: power exterior mirrors, tilt steering column, two 12-volt accessory power outlets, programmable automatic door locks and Soft-Ray tinted glass.



The standard center-mounted rear wiper clears a large area for excellent rearward visibility.



One or two integral, fold-down child safety seats are available with interiors that utilize modular seating.

Inner tubes, beach balls and tires can be pumped up with the auxiliary air inflator, part of Montana's standard automatic load leveling suspension. Available on Trans Sport.



Rear controls for the available rear air conditioning and heating (extended-length only) adjust airflow and levels of heating or cooling. Rear audio system controls (available on all models) enable rear-seat passengers to independently control and listen to a CD or cassette while those in front listen to the radio, or vice versa.



The available overhead front console includes Driver Information Center trip computer, readouts for outside temperature and compass headings, controls for optional equipment and convenient storage.

Properly equipped with the trailering package, Trans Sport is capable of towing up to 3,500 lbs. Automatic load leveling rear suspension helps keep the van level for maximum handling stability and proper headlamp performance.

Depending on seating configuration, Montana and Trans Sport provide up to 17 spots for cups, cans, bottles and juice boxes.



Breathe easy because high-efficiency particulate filters are standard in every model. These easy-to-change filters remove up to 90% of most pollen, dust and other materials as small as five microns. Front air conditioning is standard.

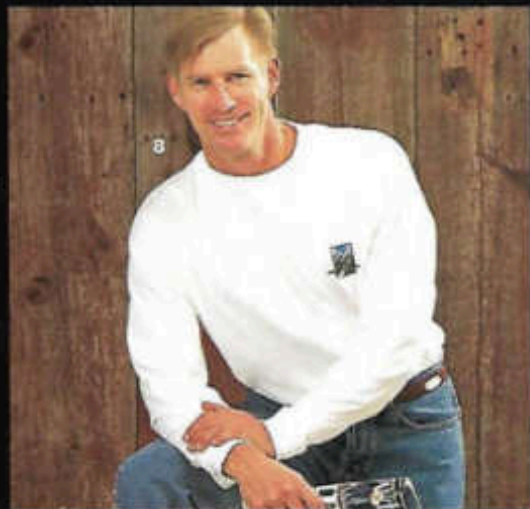
